Homework with specific tasks is good such as Minute Maths. Education City is really good alternative to traditional learning. Creativity has been a key focus and my child has benefited from this – her confidence has grown significantly. My child being happy and settled in their environment.

Excellent trip to the Deep- fabulous Christmas Concerts and the fortnightly homework for class 3 is definitely helpful! The TAG rugby – my child has thoroughly enjoyed this - especially the tournament – excellent experiences for the children.

The Friendship concert! – Beautiful and moving – excellent standard of singing produced by the children. Well done to the whole team – school just keeps on improving and the standard of teaching is exceptional!

Do you have any ideas for the future?

- I think school could make better use of Barnsley Music service and offer a more diverse range of music tuition.
- A Bike shed.
- Too much homework is given.
- Would it be possible to move milk time to morning break instead of just after lunch? My child would appreciate a mid-morning boost but is always full after lunch.
- Website needs updating.
- Seek business sponsorship. Combine afterschool clubs with other schools so more can attend. Reward higher achievers with cinema tickets, free Kingswood place etc. Have a weekly raffle, lottery to raise funds.
- Staff and school to support the Penistone Children's Choir children felt let down by the lack of support at the recent Penistone Paramount concert.
- Better books in the library, improvements in the playground including a bike shed.
- Could we have a club allocated to reading?
- Improve the outdoor facilities the playground gets flooded.
- Allotment afterschool club was offered but never happened.
- Communication via text message could sometimes be better if sent further in advance and followed up with second reminders.
- Maybe a trip to the theatre? Learning could explore moral values/something as appropriate.
- A good idea would be to let parents know what team children are in for when they win especially the younger ones.
- It would be great if there were some additional sports for girls such as netball.
- The school needs to work on communication with parents and not expect the 'one size fits all' approach. Texts are overused, not kept for emergencies and assumptions made that they are acknowledged.
- Now that the weather picking up can Golden Time activities take place outside?
- Mentioning birthdays for the week in Friday's assembly?
- Lunchtime can still be a bit stressful with children falling out etc
- Maybe a better understanding on things we can do at home to support the terms projects etc
- Could any concerts maybe made into a CD to raise funds for school? Parents would love the chance to capture that special moment.

Many thanks, once again, for the time you've taken to complete the questionnaire and for your supportive and constructive comments. Some of your ideas have been passed on to individual class teacher who will give them careful consideration.

Obviously our aim is to please everyone and we go out of our way to do so – inevitably there will be times when this aim is not achieved despite our best efforts - as the saying goes "You can please some of the people all of the time, you can please all of the people some of the time, but you can't please all of the people all of the time".

However your views are *extremely* important to us as they drive our school's improvement – we will be able to address some of your ideas straight away as we deem appropriate and do-able, but budget and time constraints will mean that some may have to be added to our 'to do' list!

Here are our thoughts in response to some of your ideas for the future.

- We aim to provide a wide range of music tuition opportunities through Barnsley Music Service. We will notify parents when new instrument tuition becomes available to us.
- Homework is always a tricky one because many people have different views/opinion/expectations. Therefore we aim to provide purposeful, creative and enjoyable homework for our children. The amount of homework is appropriate for the age of pupils and tasks set provide much scope for individual children to express their learning and have fun doing so. In response to past parental concerns; we have altered our approach to homework so that, in some classes, children have a fortnight to complete their homework. This has been positively received. If you have concerns about homework, please talk to the class teacher or myself and we will do all we can to help you support and understand your child's home learning.
- The website is updated on a termly basis as appropriate and the Shuttle/new section is updated on a weekly basis. The class pages are under review.
- The school library is well resourced; however the school soon plans to purchase new books for the newly
 established mini-library.
- I am disappointed that I was unable to attend the choirs performance at the Paramount unfortunately unforeseen circumstances prevented me from going along. We will be arranging another opportunity for the children to perform to the school and I will be there to see them perform at the Thurlstone Gala.
- We hope to make some provision for bikes and scooters soon in the meantime pupils can now ride their bikes and scooters to school and leave them next to class 3 during the day.
- We will be notifying parents which team their child is in very soon a good idea!
- The text service is not meant to be for emergencies only it is a general information sharing system and is used in anyway the school sees fit. I am always happy to discuss any communication concerns, so feel free to pop in for a chat.
- Text messages are usually sent out in good time however there are occasions when short notice is unavoidable. We do text reminders relating to events detailed in the Shuttle or specific letters but don't always have enough time, or see the need to send 2nd text reminders.
- An after- school allotment club has not been offered, however we do have plans to offer a Golden Time allotment club now that the weather is improving.
- Even though some Golden time activities have been outside during the winter months, more Gold Time activities will DEFINITELY be outside now the weather is picking up!
- Mentioning birthdays in Special Mentions assembly is another nice idea!
- I am currently looking into producing a CD of the Friendship Concert! Watch this space!
- The P.T.A is currently focusing their fundraising efforts on developing further our playground and outdoor
 environment. Your support of P.T.A fundraising events is always appreciated however we ask that you
 understand that raising funds takes time and effort so developments and improvements will happen steadily
 throughout the year. The P.T.A has paid for the new playground benches some more are being installed soon –
 a massive thanks for their efforts!
