School Uniform from September 2011

Further to the letter that went home last week, we would like to emphasise and clarify what your child can and can't wear to school. **This will be enforced from September 2011.**

Your child <u>may</u> wear:

- A Thurlstone uniform hoodie, sweatshirt or cardigan (or fleece if your child is in Y6)
- A white or 'Thurlstone Blue' polo shirt
- Dark grey or black trousers/shorts for boys
- Dark grey or black trousers/skirt/school pinafore dress for girls
- Dark grey/black or navy blue leggings may be worn by girls under skirts instead of tights in cold weather (we understand leggings are more convenient than tights particularly on P.E days!)
- Blue and white checked summer dresses for girls
- White, dark grey or black socks for both girls and boys
- Dark coloured footwear(black, dark grey, brown) shoes or trainers for both girls and boys
- Navy blue, black or dark grey tights for girls.
- Small stud earrings
- A watch if desired
- P.E kit comprising of white t-shirt and black shorts for both boys and girls (girls may also wear a leotard if desired) black joggers may be worn in the winter.
- A warm, sensible coat

Your child <u>may not</u> wear:

- Navy blue or white cardigan/sweatshirts
- Leggings worn with summer dresses
- Leggings worn with skirts/dresses on warm days
- Jogging bottoms (the ones with elasticated leg cuffs) instead of trousers
- Brightly coloured leggings
- Navy blue polo shirts
- Brightly coloured trainers/sandals/shoes
- Brightly coloured/patterned socks/tights
- Necklaces
- Bracelets
- Hoop or dangly earrings
- Colours other than black for their P.E kit shorts/joggers
