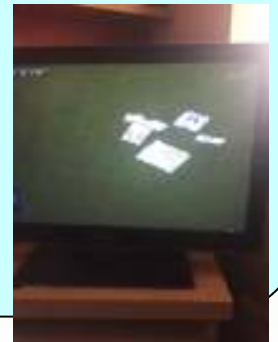

Poster Competition Rules

1. The children must be aged 11 (or 12 in some cases) – year 6 and below.
2. The competition entries will be placed into two age categories:
 - Up to age 7
 - Age 7 and over
3. There must only be one entry per child.
4. Any material may be used to make the poster, for example, collage, paint, crayon's, mosaic, pencil or material, as long as the work is the child's own.
5. The poster must be **A4** size, and may be landscape or portrait.
6. The poster's aim is to publicise Barnsley In Bloom and the design should be on a floral theme. The winner, 2 runners up and the Mayor's Highly Commended entries will be displayed in Barnsley in Bloom 2017 publicity.
7. There can be no guarantee that posters will be returned. Please indicate on the entry if you would like them to be returned, and then all efforts will be made to do so.
8. Please mark clearly on the back of each poster the child's name, age and school or club name.
9. A prize will be awarded to the winner and their school.
10. There will be a presentation event and media coverage of the competition which participants will be requested to participate in.
11. The closing date for entries is Friday 26th May 2017.
12. The judges' decision is final, and correspondence will not be entered into.
