We have had one confirmed case of SCARLET FEVER so please be watchful of the following symptoms.

- **Red lines or streaks around the armpits, elbows and knees**
- **Flushed face**
- **Strawberry tongue, or a white tongue with red dots on the surface**
- **Red, sore throat with white and yellow patches**
- **Fever above 101 degrees F (38.3 degrees C)**
- **Chills**
- **Headaches**
- **Swollen tonsils**

If your child has been diagnosed with Scarlett Fever they can return to school 24 hours after starting anti-biotics (if they feel well enough)
