



#### PENALTY NOTICE FINES FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ARE CHANGING.

#### Please read carefully.

With the introduction of the new <u>National Framework for Penalty Notices</u>, the following changes will come into force for Penalty Notice Fines after 19<sup>th</sup> August 2024

#### PER PARENT, PER CHILD FINES

Penalty Notice Fines will now be issued to each parent, for each child that is absent. FOR EXAMPLE: 3 siblings absent for term time leave, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

#### 5 CONSECUTIVE DAYS OF TERM TIME LEAVE

Penalty Notice Fines will be issued for term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days. Inset training days are school days and can be included in the 5 or more consecutive days where there was intent to be absent for term time leave.

#### 10 SESSIONS OF UNAUTHORISED ABSENCE IN A 10 WEEK PERIOD

Penalty Notice Fines will be considered when there have been 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in any 10 week period.

#### FIRST OFFENCE

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for term time leave or irregular attendance, the amount will be: £160 per parent, per child is paid within 28 days.

This will be reduced to £80 per child, per parent is paid within 21 days.

#### SECOND OFFENCE (within 3 years)

The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for term time leave or irregular attendance, the amount will be:
£160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days.

#### THIRD OFFENCE AND ANY FURTHER OFFENCES (within 3 years)

The third time an offence is committed for term time leave or irregular attendance, a Penalty Notice will not be issued. Instead, the case will be presented straight to the Magistrates' Court.

Magistrates' fines can be up to £2500 per parent, per child.

Cases found guilty in Magistrates Court can show on the parent's future DBS certificate due to 'failure to safequard a child's education'.

Please note that the above are nation-wide changes and not devised by the school.
