WHAT WILL YOUR CHILD BE LEARNING?

Foundation Stage 2, or Reception, is an exciting year for 4 to 5-yearolds. It focuses on developing essential skills through play and handson activities. ChildrYour children will explore Communication and Language, Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Physical Development, Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding the World, and Expressive Arts and Design. Our teachers support their growth in language, maths, social skills, and coordination, fostering curiosity and confidence. This stage prepares children for a smooth transition to Key Stage 1. We hope you will join in your child's learning by supporting skill development at home.

Afterwards, we do our phonics, where we learn about letters and sounds and start to learn to read
and spell words!

It is amazing how quickly we learn to read once we start our phonics learning in school! We practise our writing at this time too.

For the rest of the morning we learn with our friends and teachers in our classroom provision or in our outdoor learning area. We call this, 'Learning with Friends' time. We love this special time. When it is morning playtime, we play outside in the playground with some of the other children in school. All of the children at our school are very friendly!

After playtime, we sit on our carpet with our teacher and have lots of fun learning about numbers, before we continue 'Learning with Friends' in our classroom provision or outdoor area.
