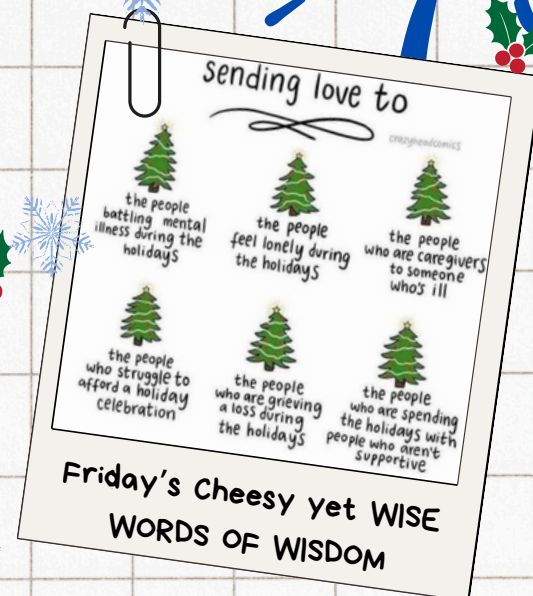

ONLINE SAFETY GUIDE

Helping families navigate the online world safely.

As Christmas approaches, many parents/carers will be looking to buy their children the latest gadgets and technology, from phones, tablets to gaming consoles. While these gifts can bring joy and open new doors for learning and entertainment, it's essential to remember the importance of online safety. With children and young people spending more time online, parents must ensure they understand the risks of the digital world, like cyberbullying or inappropriate content. It's important to set up parental controls, have open conversations about internet safety, and support your child to recognise potential dangers and create a safer online experience.



TOP TIPS

HEALTHY ONLINE HABITS...

Taking a break from social media over the holidays can be a refreshing way to focus on real-world connections, reduce stress, and prioritize your mental well-being.



SETTING UP PARENTAL CONTROLS

Talk to your child before setting up parent controls, discuss why they are in place. Be open and honest.



Use a parent control app such as Family Link app, Family Microsoft or google account.



Set up safety controls on your WIFI Router. You can do this in your WIFI settings or contact your internet provider for support.



Enable safe search filters on Google and YouTube or turn onto restricted mode.

Using a parent control app allows you to limit screen time, approve apps and games before accessing and monitors browser history so you can see what your child is accessing online.



Make sure your child knows you want to help them build digital resilience not just limit their online behaviour!

DO YOU KNOW WHAT YOUR CHILD IS ACCESSING ONLINE?

While children and young may be tech-savvy in some areas, they often lack the experience and judgment needed to navigate the risks of the internet effectively. Children and young people may not fully understand the potential dangers, such as cyberbullying, online predators, or sharing personal information.

- Talk regularly and openly
- Set up parental controls & monitoring tools
- Monitor social media and messaging apps
- Review browser history and device usage
- Set clear rules for online behaviour
- Stay informed about new trends and apps



DID YOU KNOW?

Most games and apps that children and young people access have a chat function allowing children to chat, voice message and send/receive pictures/videos from anyone they connect with online! Even with parent controls and restrictions in place, you can't always ensure their safety!

Some social media apps/games will help with safety settings when your child downloads an app/game and makes an account, so it's really important they are always honest about their age online so the apps/games they use can help keep them safe! Even with settings in place, there is still a risk of seeing/hearing things online that may upset them or make them feel uncomfortable, worried or confused. Make sure they know how to block and report content they don't want to see and let them know you are there to help and talk about their life online whenever they need you!
